Sidney Police Department Retirement-PERS vs MPORS:

Chief Kraft provided the Sidney Police Department and the Police and Fire Committee information on switching the Police Department from PERS to MPORS for retirement. After reviewing the differences, which include only a 20 year retirement in MPORS, higher investments with less out of the Officers paycheck in MPORS and options for continuing in employment after 20 years, Chief Kraft asked the Officers in attendance who would like to switch to MPORS and get out of the PERS retirement, all of who was present supported switching.

Motion was made to approve moving forward with switching the Police Department from the PERS State Retirement to the MPORS State Retirement by Alderwoman Christensen. Alderwoman Godfrey seconded, and with no further discussion, all present voted aye.
